The New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) is pleased to announce the new E-Waste LISTSERV entitled DEP NJ ECYCLE LISTSERV. This service has been established in an effort to simplify and enhance the efficiency and distribution of DEP's E-Waste information.

Using the DEP NJ ECYCLE LISTSERV, DEP will send regular email messages to subscribers that include:

- Announcements, Notifications, Information and Guidelines
- Compliance Advisories
- Links to E-Cycle Webpage for Updates to:
 - Collection Site Locations
 - Frequently Asked Questions
 - Requirements
 - Other Information

Since DEP NJ ECYCLE LISTSERV will be DEP's primary method of communication to the regulated community, it is critical that all Manufacturers, Authorized Recyclers, Collection Site Location Operators, **Towns and Counties** subscribe. DEP also encourages all other interested parties to subscribe in order to be kept current about NJ E-Waste issues, information and news.
