TRAINING DIVISION; TRAINING MATRIX

- The following training matrix (see attached) shall be in force starting 1 January, 2012, and shall be used as the Department Guideline for all personnel training requirements/requests.
- The matrix shall be followed when the Training Division is considering applications/requests for training by department personnel.
- Any deviation from the matrix for cause or special considerations shall be approved by the Department Training Officer and/or Assistant Fire Chief.
- The Training matrix is designed around courses offered at the BCESTC.
- There are seven (7) categories: Recruit Firefighter, 1 to 2 year Firefighter, 3 year Firefighter, Officer Development, Officer Training, Fire Instructor and Fire Inspector. (See attached matrix for category descriptions)
- Department personnel that have not maintained their levels of training as according to the matrix categories shall be required to fulfill the previous category requirements prior to advancing to the next level of training. Any deviation from this requirement shall require the approval of the Department Training Officer and/or Assistant Fire Chief for cause or special considerations.
