

Engine Seating Assignments

Engine Company:

Positions will be filled in Alphabetical Order.

Driver (OP):

Engine	MVC	Truck
Drive Safely, Pump, Ladders, Provide Lighting	Drive Safely, Rescue Pump, Provide Lighting	Drive Safely, Ladders, Provide Lighting, Utilities

Officer (O):

Engine	MVC	Truck
O-Tool, TIC, Line Placement, Search & Rescue	Circle Survey, Action Plan	O-Tool, TIC, Size Up, Search & Rescue

Behind the Driver (A):

Engine	MVC	Truck
"Can-Man" Nozzle (OR) Can & 6' Hook	Primary Tool Operator	"Can-Man" Can, Flashlight, Hook

Behind the Officer (B):

Engine	MVC	Truck
"Hydrant/OV" Layout/Hydrant, Outside Vent	"Stabilization" Stabilization, Cribbing, then Set- Up 2 nd Set of Tools	"Outside Vent" Throw Ladders, Outside Vent, Assist "Roof Man"

Facing Forward closest to the Officer (C):

Engine	MVC	Truck
"Irons/Forcible Entry" Irons, Bolt Cutters, Sledge (FE), and/or Search & Rescue	"Power Supply" Tools: Wire Cutters, Adjustable Wrench, then Protection Line	"Irons/Forcible Entry" Irons, Bolt Cutters, Sledge (FE), and/or Search & Rescue

Facing Forward closest to the Driver (D):

Fire Suppression	MVC	Truck
"Back Up" Back Up Attack Line, Hook (OR) 2 nd Line	Back Up Tool or 2 nd Tool Operator	"Roof Man" Saw & Hook

Fold Down Seats (E & F)

Job as assigned by the Officer.

These seats are last to be filled when responding.
