Subject: Ambulance Inventory Checks

Ambulance inventory checks are to be completed no earlier than 3 hours before or two hours after the start of each duty crew for the day. The exception to this is if the time frame is precluded by calls then the check will be completed as soon as possible. If the compartment has a locked and numbered seal the seal number shall be written down and the compartment regarded as being completed in its inventory. If the seal is broken the crew will count the contents of the compartment and replace what is needed then reseal the compartment writing down the new seal number. If there is not sufficient stock to replenish the compartment an email will be sent to the EMS Lt. and the compartment will be left unsealed. Ambulance inventory checks are to be completed by all members of the duty crew. Failure to complete the check will result in loss of credit for the duty crew for the member who failed to complete the inventory check.
