On April 2, 2014 we will be placing Engine 1812 into service. It has been equipped with extra brush fire hand tools, forestry hand lines, brush truck refill adaptors, and water cans.

Engine 1812 will be used by Station 1 as first out for all Brush Fires, Rubbish Fires, Wires Calls, & Car Fires (Non-MVC).

It will be used on GRIDS 1810-1819 24/7 & GRIDS 1830-1839 Monday-Friday 0600-1800. It can also be special called to any other call by the OIC or Chief responding to the call.

All Driver/Operators of Class A Engines are to become acquainted with the operations of Engine 1812. If you are in need of refresher training please contact Capt. South or Battalion Chief Jakob.
